

Online publication of student theses (e.g. bachelor- and master theses)

The institutional repository [Refubium](#) provides Freie Universität students with a free-of-cost-framework to electronically publish student theses. An own collection ensures the research and download of student theses. Within the submission process the student enter into a publication agreement with the University library to archive the document. All rights remain by the author.

The terms of submission according to the currently applicable study and examination regulations of Freie Universität Berlin remain unaffected. (see also <https://www.fu-berlin.de/en/studium/studienorganisation/pruefung/index.html>).

Up to winter semester 2019/2020 student degree theses will be included in the stock of the library system in electronic form only. The inclusion is performed by way of releasing the work in the Freie Universität institutional repository, Refubium, and will be carried out at the candidates' initiative. In the future, paper copies will not be accepted any more by the libraries.

For the inclusion of bachelor and master theses in Refubium a recommendation of the supervisors of the work is necessary. This can be uploaded after the submission of metadata in Refubium.
